Some of you may have attended a workshop or presentation by Michael Harvey. Michael has visited our diocese from the U.K. a number of times. Most recently he met with ministers in the Erin-Hillsburgh area. Michael Harvey's" claim to fame which he humbly would not claim at all is that he is the founder of the "**Back to Church Movement**". When a church decides to engage with the " Back to Church Program", the main component involves members of the congregation inviting their friends, relatives neighbours and lapsed members to church. We all invite people to our homes, to go for coffee, to go to the theatre and so on, but for some reason, we can encounter a block when inviting someone to come to church.

**Do not fear , only believe** ( Mark 5 – 36 )

# Do not be afraid, Mary, for you have found favour with God. (Luke 1 - 30)

I think inviting someone to come to *Cursillo* is very similar. Michael Harvey would say that one of the blocks that gets in our way is fear. When faced with a situation in which what we ask may be rejected, We fear that rejection. Harvey reminds us that Jesus faced rejection regularly and the Apostles inherited that legacy as well. Not everyone who heard Paul preach became a follower of Christ. No Evangelist has a 100% record! We have to be reminded often that as beloved of God we do not need to fear. Remember how the Angel came to Mary to invite her to be the mother of Jesus , began with "*Do not be afraid*". God is so seriuos about not wanting us to be afraid that ; that phrase appears 366 times in scripture. (according to Mr. Harvey's research) I did not try to count myself!!

Another of Mr. Harveys wise teachings about invitation is how we define success. The way of the world tells us that success is getting the result we want. Michael suggests this is too narrow a definition. Our goal is to invite , so success is extending that invitation. The choice belongs to the person invited. That "yes" or "no" is in God's hands. We have succeeded in doing our part if we made the invitation.

When you are ready to invite a friend to *Cursillo* keep inmind that you are offering someone a gift. It is of an opportunity to set aside time to learn about God and to be still and be with God. It is a time to

talk about things that really matter. It is a time for someone to learn about God, themselves and others and grow from that knowledge. An invitation to Cursillo is an opportunity to bring joy into someone's life. You are offering a gift of value.

Prepare for the invitation with prayer. Practice a simple way to broach the subject. Have a brochure available. It is available on the website. Suggest the person think about it and come back to you with their questions. Answer these questions directly. Share some of what the weekend experience meant to you. With this you have succeeded in inviting.

Similar to the fear of rejection, another fear we face is judgement. Sometimes that judging begins with ourselves. We invite a friend to Cursillo and then before we give them a chance to say" yes" or

"no" we decide that they will probably say "no" for any number of reasons. And so we never ask because we are sure we know the answer already. Imagine that, we think we know better what is best for a person than that person does ! You never know who God may be inviting.

There is still time to offer someone you know a special gift – the gift of the *Cursillo* experience. Do not be afraid. Pray about that person . Pray about your own fears. Let the Spirit guide you through the process. There is time for you to invite someone to *Weekend #49* in April or *Weekend # 50* in Oct/Nov.


